

**PROCLAMATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY  
PURSUANT TO §24 OF THE EXECUTIVE LAW  
OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK**


WHEREAS, the Town Supervisor, as the Chief Executive Officer of the Town of Cornwall, is empowered to proclaim a local state of emergency within the unincorporated area of the Town of Cornwall pursuant to the provisions of Section 24 of the New York State Executive Law for a period of up to thirty (30) days; and

WHEREAS, the existing pandemic of corona virus (COVID-19) has produced public health emergency within the unincorporated area of the Town of Cornwall;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the powers vested in me as Supervisor of the Town of Cornwall and pursuant to Section 24 of the Executive Law of the State of New York, I do hereby proclaim that the state of emergency established on June 11, 2020 which shall continue until July 11, 2020, unless a proclamation lifting the state of emergency is issued at an earlier date.
